Footnotes

MISS MOSES tracked the pacesetters while saving ground to the stretch, came around a tiring rival entering the stretch before angling back to the rail, rallied inside rivals a to challenge a furlong out and drew clear late. MY TIME NOW raced four wide entering the first turn while close up, angled inward midway on the bend, stalked the pace to the stretch, rallied to challenge in upper stretch, continued willingly but could not match strides with the winner late. PLATINUM BALLET was unhurried to the final turn, raced four wide on the bend, rallied to loom a threat outside rivals in midstretch but was outfinished late. THIS ONE FOR ABBEY settled well off the early pace, angled out approaching the stretch, came five wide entering the lane, rallied to loom a danger between rivals in midstretch but was also outfinished late. FLY AWAY ANGEL moved up outside of FLY AWAY ANGEL to vie for command on the backstretch, dueled to midstretch before weakening late. DEFUHR went clear from the rail early, was headed early on the backstretch, dueled to the stretch before tiring. TOUCH OF VICTORY was outrun while racing inside.
