PJ'S HALO was allowed to settle early, moved up four wide and finished gamely to get up under all out pressure. TRUE TEAR DROPS stalked the pace, drifted out a bit nearing the sixteenth pole and caused Miss Valedictorian to check strides. UCANDOITTOO pressed the pace from the outside and weakened. MISS VALEDICTORIAN was off slowly, moved up four wide around the far turn, flattened out late and was forced to check nearing the sixteenth due to a drifting out rival. RUBIETTA stalked the pace, saved ground throughout and hung in the final stages. TRICKY TAMI raced evenly and never was a factor. TIPPYS MORNINGSTAR failed to menace. GROOVY HERO was away alertly, set all the pace while racing along the inside and tired badly.
