LEMON ZING moved to the lead outside rivals completing six furlongs then turned back the challenge of BUSTER'S CREW in the stretch. BUSTER'S CREW moved up outside rivals on the far turn, loomed boldly through the stretch but lacked the needed late kick. PALMETTO JIM moved up along the inside into the stretch then lacked the needed closing response. MARITIME MAGIC was outrun early then responded well in the drive but was too late. DOUBLE DUTCH BUS broke alertly to dispute the pace for six furlongs then tired. WEST IS BEST showed little. BEELZEBUB vied for the early lead then tired.
