### Footnotes

DEPUTY NOTICE raced wide, took the lead near stretch, was clear mid stretch and won under strong handling. NEON TAN was between foes, raced in traffic on the backstretch, swung out on the final turn but had no late gain. ROCK PTARMIGAN was far back early, raced very wide into stretch and was much too late. VANDER GELDER saved ground just off the pace and tired. ZOOT SUIT JOHNNY was out from the rail and just off pace, took the lead on the final turn, tired. SILVER SKATES was three wide and was no real threat. L'EMPEREUR raced between foes and tired. APIANUS saved ground setting the early pace and tired. FLATTER ME NOW bobbled leaving the gate and raced wide. MIDNIGHT RUSH was between and just off the pace, tired badly.
