MOON ECLIPSE dueled three wide, began to inch away mid stretch and then lasted under pressure. LUBANGO vied inside, was eased back a bit on the final turn, moved out for the stretch, closed and just missed. DEACON FURR saved ground while never far back, split rivals in the stretch and rallied. BEAR'S FUTURE dueled for command two wide and weakened slightly. LUCKY LEWIS joined for command four wide and weakened. PAYTON'S VICTORY was well placed between foes, took up sharply in tight on the final turn. SPEEDING TRAIN broke slowly, raced wide and trailed.
