KILLTHEMESSENGER bumped with foe after the start, saved ground, eased out rallying in the lane and was gaining. DUE TO A POSITIVE TEST, KILLTHEMESSENGER WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED LAST. HE ALSO FORFEITED ALL PURSE MONIES. TANNENBAUM came in after the start causing some crowding, raced well off the rail and had no late rally. RON THE LAWYER was bumped and steadied leaving the gate, saved ground and was too late. BUZZ BANQUET steadied after the start and raced wide. O K LEFTY, crowded leaving the gate, raced well off rail and was no factor. MONSIGNOR J, bumped leaving the gate, was well placed between foes and tired. T D BOB raced wide while just off the pace and tired.
