GRANDE GAYEGO was well placed close to the pace, rallied to the lead in midstretch then was no match for the winner. DISCO RHYTHM broke sharp to set the pace then faded in the drive. PADRE ED moved up wide on the far turn then flattened out in the drive. MOUNTAIN CLIMBER prompted the pace for six furlongs then tired. FIRE KING raced within striking distance to the far turn then tired. HITTERS COUNT tired.
