HENCEFORTH looped the field rallying, took the lead deep stretch and edged away. ATTACK JACK vied for command two wide, shook loose to be clear in mid stretch but then was no match. NORTHPOINT COSTAS was off slow and outrun early, split foes entering the lane, eased out through the stretch but was too late. BAVARIA was just off the rail and just off the pace, steadied briefly on the far turn, came out slightly on the turn, drifted in slightly near the sixteenth pole. FOLLOWING CLAIMS OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF COLTRAIDER, BAVARIA WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SIXTH. CANDY HEART vied for command inside, drifted out slightly near the sixteenth pole. COLTRAIDER was steadied near the quarter pole when trying to split rivals and then steadied again trying to split rivals near the sixteenth pole. DAN'S GINGER was outside and just off pace, drifted in slightly near the quarter pole and faded. ICELUS broke down in his right front in the final eighth.
