Footnotes

AYE JAY POWER circled horses leaving the turn then drifted in a bit in upper stretch and drove clear. HEROIC INDEED prompted the pace from the outset and went evenly in the final furlong. LINDA'S LAST moved up between horses on the turn then lacked the needed rally. COCO KNOWS quickly went to the front to show the way then was steadied briefly on heels when the winner drifted in in upper stretch and then faded. CHEROKEE ROAD failed to menace with a mild bid in the stretch. FLYIN HAWAIIAN L C broke sharp to prompt the pace then faded in the drive. IT'S CHARLIE AGAIN was shuffled back between rivals leaving the backstretch. CHICANERY showed little. A claim of foul by the rider of IT'S CHARLIE AGAIN against the winner for interference leaving the backstretch was not allowed.
