LUCKY LEWIS, inside second flight, eased out a bit and took the lead in early stretch, was clear with a furlong to go and won under strong handling. DEACON FURR rallied wide on the final turn, came six wide into stretch but then had no late kick. RED DOCTOBER was between foes on the backstretch, raced three near stretch and hung. FRAMED was far back early, rallied wide and belatedly. RUNNIN BULL sprinted clear just off the rail and then had little left. TYZACH, well placed between foes, was allowed to fall back on the backstretch, was left the rail and rallied again on the final turn but failed to sustain his bid. PAYTON'S VICTORY, wide in second flight, tired.
