QUITE A LEGACY broke alertly to dispute the pace, faded in the drive and held third. JALEOS broke a step slowly then continued willingly. PERFECT WIND failed to seriously menace with a mild bid. VISIGODO failed to be a serious threat. MAGICAL DREAMER lacked a rally. TONINTHIRTEEN was outrun. SAPPHIRE SANDY tired. OUR BAILIWICK showed little. FINALLY TOGETHER was no factor. DOVER POINT vied for the early lead then had little left.
