DEPUTYVILLE was off slow and outrun, rallied eleven wide wide into stretch and was along in time. KUDU split foes moving, took the lead deep stretch but couldn't last. STEALTH MISSILE moved up racing between foes but was too late. ONE SHOT (ARG) was never far back while between foes, faded. TEJANOS ELIMINATOR vied for command two wide, drifted out through the stretch and then gave way. I GOT SWAGGER raced wide while never far back and then tired. FIRST GOLD was wide and just off the pace, drifted out then in and gave way. CHIEF OPERATOR broke slowly and failed to menace. SHAWKLIT POWER bobbled leaving the gate. MR. W. B. saved ground and tired. BEARIFIC set the pace inside and stopped.
