MACHO MO MON was outside second flight, rallied to the lead near mid stretch and slowly edged away. UNIQUELY didn't break sharply, rallied between foes through stretch and closed for place. NORTE GRANDE set the pace out from the rail and weakened late. FOURLEAF STREET raced wide and rallied too late. DON'S HONOUR saved ground just off the pace, weakened. MAD TUNES was outside just off pace, took up trying to split foes in deep stretch. MENTIDOSO was very wide into and through stretch and was too late. GUNPOWDER CREEK saved ground, was blocked trying to rally through deep stretch. SAINTLY ZEALOUS prompted outside, steadied retreating in deep stretch. SETTLE THE SCORE broke slow and was far back. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF MAD TUNES AGAINST UNIQUELY FOR INTERFERENCE IN DEEP STRETCH WAS DISMISSED. MOISES, WHO WAS VERY FRACTIOUS IN THE STARTING GATE AND SUFFERED A SERIOUS INJURY TO HIS LEFT HIND LEG, WAS ORDERED SCRATCHED ON THE ADVICE OF THE VETERINARIANS. MOISES STOOD IN FRONT OF THE STARTING GATE AND HAD TO BE VANNED FROM THE TRACK. THE RIDERS OF THE REMAINING RUNNERS DISMOUNTED. ONCE THE VAN DEPARTED, A TRACTOR WAS BROUGHT ONTO THE TRACK TO HARROW THE AREA IN FRONT OF THE STARTING GATE. CURIOUSLY, THE RIDERS DIDN'T BEGIN TO REMOUNT UNTIL THREE MINUTES AFTER THE TRACTOR HAD EXITED THE TRACK. IN ALL, THERE WAS A 22 MINUTE DELAY IN POST TIME.
