PISCITELLI was well placed close to the pace then ran down the leader in the final furlong and drove clear. RED JACK was well placed just off the pace and lacked the needed closing response. BEST JAZZ was outrun early then rallied wide and ran down rival in time for third. MR. AST moved to the lead three wide on the far turn then faded in the drive. BELLE'S BIG BOY failed to be a serious threat. VILLAS STORM saved ground disputing the early pace then weakened. SINGING MY WAY disputed the pace for six furlongs then weakened. THRILL FACTOR lacked a rally. GREAT BIG BANG showed little. TRULY A CHAMP was no factor. DEPORTISTA tired.
