NAUGHTY AND BOLD lacked a rally. HOLY BEAR was forwardly placed along the inside to the far turn then tired. STOCK QUOTE tired. MANOS DE PIEDRA didn't break alertly then was outrun. ONE NICE RAE tired. LOOKIN AT OPTIONS was through early.
