LESLY'S BACK saved ground, was steadied lacking room deep stretch, moved out, split foes, accelerated and was up in time. STRANGER THINGS was fractious in the start gate and then was bumped after the start, rallied very wide and was outfinished. BETTERN BISCUITS was steadied along on the backstretch, eased out, took the lead deep stretch but couldn't last. PRINCESSOFTHELAND came out after the start, vied two wide and weakened late. WISH AHEAD raced wide and failed to menace. GREAT INTUITION came in leaving the gate, was well placed and then faded. GETTING BOLD raced wide and bid on turn but then gave way. SWIFT ACTION broke slowly, was hustled up inside and then tired.
