COACH SHAW lodged his bid from the outside and ran down the leader in the late yards. CLAM BAKE moved to the lead inside rivals with a half mile remaining, drew clear in upper stretch then was caught late. BULLET RAIN angled out in upper stretch then closed well for third. LOBO DEL NORTE chased from the outset and responded well in the drive. GONE TRAJECTORY was outrun to the stretch then finished well to close the gap. GRANDE showed speed from the outset then lacked the needed rally. ZURI MWANA broke sharp to duel for the lead to upper stretch then weakened. MISTER ROY (ARG) tired. TIGERHEAT stumbled at the start then vied for the early lead and tired.
