PRINTING PRESS vied for command three wide and then was no match. SCORE THE GOLD dueled for command between foes and held on well. KINGOFTHEBLUEGRASS, wide under rating, was set down much too late to threaten. BEAR'S FUTURE saved ground vying for command and tired. TYZACH saved ground just off the pace and tired.
