ENGLISH MANOR broke sharp to vie for the lead near the inside rail and was put to steady pressure to turn back the challenge of THROW'N SMOKE through the stretch. THROW'N SMOKE moved up outside rivals on the turn and loomed boldly through the stretch but was not good enough. ZIPPED CODE was outrun to the stretch then was going well at end to close the gap. BOOTLEGGIN CAT was well placed racing close up along the inside but lacked the needed rally. SNEAKY DEVIL was forwardly placed between horses and lacked the needed closing response. BAY STATE JUSTICE broke in a tangle then disputed the pace and faded in the drive. CONMAN broke a step slowly. FOREIGN OFFICER bobbed at the start then was used up vying for the early lead.
