GOT IT COVERED dueled for command two wide, was left with clear lead on the final turn, fell back in mid stretch but then came on again to win going away. PATTY MAY COME was outrun early, tried to split rivals near the stretch but was blocked and forced to angle out nine wide to secure racing room and gained place. MYPRINCESSABIGAIL was outrun early, rallied wide but was too late. MY LILY LANE rallied outside, took the lead and was clear with a furlong to run but then faltered. PLEASE BE QUIET split rivals moving, lacked a strong finish. CUVEE MADAME saved ground, steadied on the final turn and then steadied again lacking room entering the stretch. ALEJA GRAND was well placed off the rail and tired. QUINCY LEE was just off the rail and just off the pace, faded. RENAISSANCE GIRL, wide stalking, tired. PERFECT WEDDING dueled for command inside, broke down on the final turn and was humanely euthanized.
