LASTCALLFORDISCO saved ground, moved out three wide racing into the stretch, swung wider in early stretch but then faded. CARIBBEAN BEAU vied for command two wide and tired. GREEK GOLD was far back and failed to menace. PAL PETEY bore out badly on the turn and was pulled up. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF LASTCALLFORDISCO AGAINST TAP STAR FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS DISMISSED.
