SUE THEM ALL racing out from the rail while not far back, eased out wider racing into the stretch, took the lead leaving furlong grounds and drew clear. DEEP WATER set the pace just off rail, repulsed repeated challenges on the final turn, opened up again mid stretch but then was no match for winner. LOOKINGATLANGFUHR, lapped on winner, was fanned wider into stretch, faded. SECRET SHIFTERS broke slowly, moved up between foes and then was left with rail and gave way. WINNING DEAL was out from the rail and just off the pace, tired. GRIFFIN ROCK failed to menace. SUDDEN CALM showed little. BESTBANDEVER steadied between foes on the backstretch, challenged and then gave way. TENTH WAVE, well placed between foes, steadied on the far turn and then tired.
