PERFECT GENTLEMAN was outrun to the stretch then responded well in the drive to close the gap. LITTLE PEP was unhurried early then rallied mildly to gain the show. QUALITY KING bobbled on heels after the start then continued well. JALEOS moved closer around the far turn then lacked a further bid. BYGOLLY failed to be a threat. JOHNNY TWO BY FOUR broke alertly to forwardly placed then weakened in the drive. MARKET CAP was sent up along the inside into the far turn then weakened. SENOR LOUIE broke alertly to show the way through the backstretch then tired.
