LOCKUP outrun early, rallied inside and was just up. FANCY RUNNER vied for command well off the rail, battled gamely and just failed. DIAMOND DISTRICT raced and rallied wide, challenged but then hung. BERNULLI vied off the rail, fell back on the final turn, eased out and was coming back. LOFTY BANNER, very wide, failed to menace. DANCING NICK vied for command just off the rail and tired. SOVEREIGN FUND failed to menace. OLDHAM showed little.
