PAT THE BAT moved up between leaving the far turn, gained the lead with a furlong remaining then drove clear. CONMAN moved up wide around the far turn then finished well for second. SABA'S BOY broke alertly to share the early lead then continued well in the drive. BOCCO BOY shook loose leaving the backstretch then weakened in the drive. HE'S SO EVIL was away in good order then lacked a rally. ROB THE BANK raced within striking distance but could gain little in the drive. CAT N WEST tired. CRIME TIME tired. IN THE BUILDING stumbled at the start unseating his rider. A stewards inquiry was conducted into the start. A SLOW GATE LOAD RESULTED IN A 5 MINUTE DELAY OF THE START.
