QUIET THANKS controlled pace from the start, extended his margin on the turn and remained clear under mild urging. GRAND TERROR raced three wide stalking the pace and was up after a long duel for the place. MANY CROWS was eased back inside after the opening quarter, angled wide and closed well. UNCLE ELI saved ground throughout and continued well while no threat. MEMO ME dropped far behind and was never a factor. PINE HAWK pursued the pacesetter between rivals for half a mile then stopped.
