YOUNG TROUBADOR outrun early, advanced six wide on the turn, moved very wide into the lane, closed strongly and was up late. STONES THROW rallied between rivals near the stretch, closed well but was outfinished. DOMESTIC CIRCLE prompted the pace wide, continued outside and finished well. MR ADRIANO was prominent up from outset, held a clear lead in midstretch but weakened. RASHER saved ground forcing the pace and faltered. ELUSIVE MANNER dropped back early, moved inside in the lane and was no factor. FORBIDDEN CIGAR was always outrun. MR. BRAGGADOCIO broke alertly to set a clear pace for a quarter mile and was done after half a mile. CLASSY ORIENTATION raced far back throughout. GERARD LOVES BEER broke in a tangle, rushed up inside, was in tight near the far turn then stopped.
