### Footnotes

BELLAMY XPRESS quickly sprinted clear, extended his margin in the stretch and was never menaced. DIXIE'S LAST LAUGH broke sluggishly, advanced inside on the final turn but proved no match for the winner. AYE JAY POWER saved ground while close up, was put to urging on the final turn and lacked a bid. SENOR LOUIE prompted the pace outside for half a mile then weakened. ONE FAST SARAVA dropped back early outside, made a brief bid on the final turn then flattened out. STRIKE DOWN was fanned very wide on the first turn and stopped abruptly.
