BELLAGIO, away in good order, rallied between horses into the stretch to join for the lead then held off the challenge of THE LAST WAVE. THE LAST WAVE, unhurried early, angled wide in upper stretch for room to advance then closed gamely and just missed. ROUGH ROAD AHEAD, forwardly placed between rivals, loomed boldly in the stretch but was not quite good enough. PLURACITY prompted the pace outside rivals and lacked the needed closing kick. NOT FOR MONEY broke alertly to show the way and gave way grudgingly. SHOULDABEENACLOWN failed to menace. STORM THE FIELD prompted the pace to the stretch then weakened in the drive. NORTHPOINT COSTAS raced close up along the inside to the stretch then tired.
