Footnotes

PLUMARIA broke sharp and set the pace racing off the inside rail, bumped with rival entering the stretch then prevailed under steady pressure. ELITE HONOR moved up outside rivals leaving the turn, bumped with the winner entering the stretch then lacked the needed closing response. RUN CAPTIVE RUN chased from the outset then lacked the needed closing response. ALBERTINA was outrun early then responded well in the drive to close gradually. BIG VARIETY was away in good order then lacked the needed rally. PLATINUM CHARM showed early speed then weakened. MORE THAN CRAFTY was outrun. A claim of foul by the rider of ELITE HONOR against the winner for interference entering the stretch was not allowed.
