Footnotes

WISE JANE was outrun early, rallied very wide on the turn and into stretch, took the lead leaving sixteenth pole and won under strong handling. TINY PREDICAMENT dueled wide, bumped with foe turn, took the lead but was outfinished. RULING POWER was well placed between foes, steadied when bumping with foe on the turn, weakened late. DEPUTY DILLON was well placed outside, weakened. SPANISH WILDCAT vied for command well off the rail and faded. DARK INVADER was just off the pace, weakened. CASEY'S MONSTER dueled for command inside, faded. DUDAMEL broke in a tangle, advanced very wide but then gave way. SUNSHINE SMOKEY was never far back early, dropped back. DANGEROUS WARRIOR dueled for the early lead and tired.
