MR ADRIANO rallied along the inside into the stretch to challenge for the lead into the final furlong and prevailed. ALLEN'S TOUCH DOWN found room between horses into the stretch closed closed willingly. WET 'N WILD CAT broke alertly to be forwardly placed and responded well in the drive. BORN TO THE PURPLE broke sharp to show the way to the furlong grounds and gave way grudgingly. TORRO MIA was forwardly placed outside rivals and lacked the needed closing response. HITTIN THE NOTE chased from the outset then faded in the drive. RASHER showed little. JIMMY THE ROOFER tired.
