RECORD HIGH was outrun early then moved up along the inside rail in upper stretch and closed determinedly to get up late. EMOTIONAL TRIPPI moved up outside the leader on the far turn, loomed boldly through the stretch then was caught late. QUITTERS NEVER WIN closed well between rivals in the final furlong to gain the show. MISSBAUER rallied wide through the stretch to close the gap late. MICHAELA'S CANDI raced removed from the inside rail showing the way and gave way grudgingly. IN THE EVENING raced within striking distance but lacked the needed closing response. RIGHT NICE PHILLY prompted the pace then faded in the drive. OUR MARY B. prompted the early pace then tired.
