BELIEVING IN HEROS moved up menacingly outside the winner on the far turn, bumped with rival in upper stretch then was no match for the winner. BERRY GIRL rallied three wide leaving the far turn, bumped with rival in upper stretch then faded. HUMBLE BY NATURE prompted the pace from the outset then weakened in the drive. CHERRY SHAKE bobbled at the start then failed to be a threat. GET THE PICTURE showed little. DIG tired from her early effort. REIGN JAZZ showed little.
