BUDDYS MOON responded well in the drive to get up for the show. SPRICKETT lacked the needed response in the stretch and finished best of the others. ZEALEVO chased from the outset then weakened in the drive. HE BE SOMETHIN failed to be a threat. MASTER DECEIVER prompted the early pace and tired. SHABDEEZ failed to be a threat. FORGOTTEN VOW bobbled at the start then was no factor. NANA'S WINNER was through early. ZIPREME showed little.
