QUOTABLE was bumped leaving the gate, set the pace out from the rail and then was no match. WON THE WAR raced wide while just off the pace, faded. SLAMMIN' SLEW split foes and rallied too late. BRISTOL DANCER saved ground and tired. LEAWOOD TEEL came in sharply after the start causing crowding, was well placed outside and tired. NOFINANCINGNEEDED was bothered after the start, and then took up again soon after.
