BUDDY'S SONG lunged and broke slowly, moved up very wide, dueled wide, regained the lead in deep stretch and drew off. STORM WIND raced very wide and rallied for place. EL DUBAI raced just off rail, took the lead near mid stretch but then weakened. BERNING BLAZE saved ground, eased out entering the lane but had no late kick. LOFTY BANNER raced between under rating, challenged on the final turn but then flattened out. MIDNIGHT'S CHILD vied for command between foes, gave way and was being eased up late. RUNAWAY BRUTE failed to menace. BERT'S TOO KINKY raced wide, was in distress in his right front through the stretch, was eased across the wire and vanned off.
