HELLO LOVER moved to the lead near the inside leaving the turn and drew clear then was roused sharply to hold rival safe. PLURACITY showed speed from the outset and responded well in the drive to close the gap. RAISED FOR SPEED raced close up between horses and lacked the needed rally. DRYFLY showed the way racing well removed from the inside rail then faded in the drive. LOBO DEL NORTE lacked a solid rally. CABARET COWBOY chased through the turn then weakened. BARDI'S AT NOON showed early speed between horses then tired.
