MUSKWA raced outside while just off the pace and faded. OOPERS HERE was wide and tired. INDIAN RESERVATION was wide and failed to menace. ROMO TO T O, very wide, was no factor. OUT DRINKIN' showed little. WHO'S BIG DADDY saved ground and tired.
