Footnotes

LONDON TOWN angled inside setting a clear pace and was never seriously threatened while kept to a drive. SECRET INFATUATION made a menacing inside move into the final turn, angled out into the stretch and made a gradual gain. IRISH EDDIE K outrun early, advanced inside down the backstretch, moved out into the stretch and flattened out. STORM WIND was eased back off the early pace and angled outside then faded on the final turn. CELERITAS PLUS dropped far behind then passed fading rivals. EL DUBAI was asked for a rally four wide on the final turn and faded. TARGET PRACTICE prompted the pace in the three path for half a mile then stopped. EVEN FRISKY broke a step slowly and raced far back throughout.
