Footnotes

SLICK IDEA engaged the pacesetter after a quarter mile then edged away in the final furlong under steady handling. BIG PUSH raced between rivals early then found his best stride too late outside. PHILLY BOUND set a clear pace early, vied inside through the turn then weakened in the stretch. BULLET RAIN allowed to settle wide, split rivals advancing near the far turn then offered only a mild bid. RAISED FOR SPEED was close up early along the inside and began fading on the turn. CATALINA FOG bobbed at the break, moved inside and was no factor. DIAMOND DISTRICT dropped back wide on the turn, and was not persevered with through the stretch.
