CRAFTY PEACE took over at the three quarter pole, rated clear down the backstretch and drew off in the lane under steady hand urging. FALSE DILEMMA settled off the pace outside, came through the turn seven wide, started a drive into the stretch and closed for place widest. DR CLOSE CALL rated off the pace about the three path, bid toward the rail nearing the quarter pole but leveled off the final furlong. DOMESTIC CIRCLE was kept close to the early pace from the outside, continued the chase five wide on the turn then leveled off through the lane. BAK had a brief lead on the chute but was no further threat. MEMO ME, off the pace inside, bid near the rail through the turn, had aim at the quarter pole, eased out entering the lane then weakened. FORBIDDEN CIGAR stalked the pace about the three path on the backstretch then lost ground weakening on the turn. PINCH HITTER stalked the pace off the rail, gave chase on the turn then weakened from the top of the stretch.
