LOUIE'S TERRA settled close to the early pace inside, started his drive about the four path into the turn and closed steadily through the stretch to get up the final yards. WILDCAT KID, quickly clear, saved ground to rate the pace, was prompted toward the eighth pole though outfinished the final yards. STONES THROW chased the pace two deep, saved ground on the turn and gained steadily through the final furlong. WEB SURFER chased the pace toward mid track, came through the turn six wide and finished evenly outside. LONDON EYE chased the early pace toward mid track, saved some ground through the turn, came out a path nearing the eighth pole and finished evenly. BRITEN BEACH gave chase from the outside and finished evenly. RAYBERN'S GOLD showed no early speed inside, eased out entering the stretch, steadied at the heels of London Eye nearing the eighth pole and finished evenly when clear. SWASHBUCKLER showed no speed off the rail, angled out entering the stretch but had no rally widest.
