**Footnotes**

EZE DOES IT hesitated at the start, chased very wide, advanced extremely wide into the stretch, offered a late surge and was just up in a blanket finish EZE DOES IT WAS DQ'ED DUE TO POSITIVE TEST AND PLACED LAST. LAKE FRIENDS forced the pace three wide between foes and continued gamely to the finish. LABERINTO (URU) was rank on the first turn, dueled inside, led briefly in the stretch but was outfinished. STORM THE FIELD earned a narrow lead outside early, dueled throughout and just missed. WHAT NOW steadied into the first turn, raced close up then weakened. ONE OF THE BEST saved ground off the pace, was asked for run near the far turn but had no response. PARABOLA allowed to settle outside, made a four wide bid on the final turn then faded in the lane. GARDEN TOUR trailed early, raced very wide on the final turn and was no factor. CHEROKEE RAIDER prompted the pace four wide to the stretch then gave way.
