Footnotes

MONTE, between horses the opening turn, rated just off the pace two deep on the backstretch, bid past the seven sixteenths pole, dueled for control midstretch and dug in determinedly from there to inch ahead toward the wire. GENTLEMAN JIM rated close about the three path, saved ground making a bid nearing the final turn, dueled to the lead near the quarter pole and dug in gamely through the lane before grudgingly ceding the closing strides. I'M BROKE, unhurried off the rail, eased outward through the final turn, came under a drive at the head of the lane and was along for show. TONY'S BACK rated a short lead well off the rail, was caught nearing the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. DOLLAR MOUNTAIN stalked the pace from the inside but showed no response on the final turn. CHRIS BO BISS rated off the pace in mid track then faded on the final turn. GHOST WATCH lost contact early.
