DR. WHEAT, unhurried and well back, started his drive leaving the final turn, angled inside the pacesetter past the sixteenth pole and caught that one just under the wire. EASY REACH rated a clear lead through the final turn, was prompted into the stretch, stumbled leaving the ninth fence, recovered quickly to dig in from there but was caught at the wire. ARMSTRONG MILL stalked the pace to the final turn, bid at that point, had aim in the upper stretch but hung the final sixteenth. SHORT SHRIFT settled back in mid pack, was prompted into the final turn, had aim a furlong away but leveled off toward the wire. CLASSIC BRIDGES raced well back and never factored. AMAZIN SUN stalked the runner-up to the eighth fence then faded rounding the final turn. PYNAFORMER settled off the pace then faded from the eighth fence.
