Footnotes

FRONTIER WARRIOR stalked the early pace about the three path, took the lead at the three eighths pole and kept to steady handling to widen. CANDY HEART rated close in mid track, had aim four wide through the turn and dueled close to midstretch before yielding. GORDON BENNETT chased the pace toward mid track, lacked room nearing the three eighths pole, angled seven wide into the lane and closed well to deep stretch. BRAHMAN chased the pace from the outside, came through the turn four wide and finished evenly. ROMAN BAY chased the early pace off the rail then leveled out in the stretch. CELTIC STORM settled back outside, bid from the three eighths pole, had aim six wide at the quarter pole but leveled off in the stretch. GOLD SCORE settled close to the early pace toward the outside though flattened stride from the turn. ZONKER chased the pace inside, lacked room nearing the three eighths pole, eased out with a mild bid on the turn then weakened. REASON TO DRINK set the early pace inside, dueled at the rail through the turn then weakened from the top of the stretch. SUM CHAMP chased the pace inside then faded through the turn.
