1KISSAMEE GLITTER settled off the pace inside, bid off the rail into the final turn, eased four wide into the stretch, steadily advanced to match strides with the runner-up at the sixteenth pole and dug in from there to inch ahead the closing yards. OCTOMON stalked the pace about the three path, rallied to the front just inside the quarter pole, dueled clear midstretch, picked up the winner at the sixteenth pole, dug in gamely at that point but grudgingly ceded the closing yards. PEBBLE TO A PEARL rated back two deep, bid in the five path into the final turn and finished well in mid track. NO ACRONYMS showed no speed well back, bid off the rail into the final turn, saved ground nearing the quarter pole, steadied at the heels of Adelicate Miss into the lane then finished evenly mid track. SMART WOMAN dropped well back from early contention to save ground, settled unhurriedly through the backstretch, progressed at the rail rounding the final turn, was shut off at the heels of No Acronyms at the quarter pole, eased out into the lane and finished well toward the outside. TAYLORS IRISH rated with the early pace two deep, maintained slim control through the backstretch, contested the final turn and remained a close factor to midstretch before weakening. PROFIT raced evenly saving ground. RIVETING was outrun. L. A. GIRL, well back inside, angled outward on the final turn and had no rally. DREAM WITH US rated the early pace inside, settled close at the rail down the backstretch then leveled off on the final turn. ADELICATE

MISS stalked the pace from the inside then faded through the final turn. PILOT POINT LADY was not a factor.
