KIWI RULER was eased back and angled wide on the turn, closed with an impressive rush and quickly moved clear in the final furlong. SOUTHERN HONOR dueled along the inside, led into the stretch and continued gamely to hold the place. UPTOWN BOY dueled between rivals and continued well to the finish. CHICHARITO forced the pace three wide then weakened through the stretch. GOODS IS CRACKIN dropped back early and was never a factor. PAPA DOC saved ground and steadily retreated. BAT CAVE broke sluggishly and was always outrun. EDDYS INDELIBLE trailed inside then passed a fading rival. NATURAL TWENTY broke slowly and was far back throughout.
