CANTONIC broke alertly and set the pace inside, repulsed a strong challenge nearing the eighth pole then edged clear again. LIVINGSTON STREET pressed the winner throughout, loomed boldly in the stretch but could not get by. GRAND CASH dropped back early, saved ground to the stretch, angled out advancing into the lane then gained little. COFFEE BAR advanced nicely on the final turn inside then went evenly late. MILLENNIUM LAKES raced close up three wide to the final turn then retreated. FORTISSI MORE allowed to settle outside, made a brief bid on the final turn and flattened out. HAMPTON BAYS SUN was fanned four wide into the first turn and was finished after three quarters.
